## Application for organizations that provide AIDS Services To Participate in the New Jersey AIDS Walk

### New Jersey AIDS Walk Policy for Third Party Organizations Wishing to Participate

1. Third party organizations wishing to form a Team to walk in the New Jersey AIDS Walk (NJAW) must use the following procedures:
  - a. The organization must register a Team, and be approved by the NJAW Board, 2 weeks prior to the Walk.
  - b. Third party organizations will receive 75% of all proceeds donated to their Team. NJAW will receive 25% of Team proceeds to cover actual and administrative costs of the Walk.
    - i. Third party organizations are not eligible to receive proceeds donated anywhere else except under their registered Team.
      1. Monies mistakenly donated outside of a third party organizations Team are considered general donations to NJAW.
  - c. Third party organizations must provide AIDS Services. Proof must be provided.
    - i. Examples of proof include:
      1. Ryan White, CDC, NJDOH or HOPWA Funded organizations (but not limited to)
      2. AIDS Services included in an organizations' Mission Statement
      3. AIDS Services listed in an organizations' brochure
      4. AIDS Services promoted through use of social media
  - d. 100% of monies received from the New Jersey AIDS Walk must be used strictly for AIDS Services.
